## Business

The Business Area of Opportunity encompasses any business orientated training or projects that contribute to the economic prosperity for members and the community. Projects with 51% or more of proceeds going to the chapter are included in this category. PR and marketing events are also included in this category.

## Individual Development

This area provides an opportunity for individual members to realize their personal potential. Learning a new skill, teaching a new skill. Developing yourself intentionally. It could be something unique, essential, practical, useful, fun, or a variety of other things.

## Community

The Community Area of Opportunity embodies the line of the Jaycee creed "Service to humanity is the best work of life." Was the impact significant? Did it create positive change? Did it enhance the community? Projects where 51% or more of the proceeds go back to the community are included in this category.

## Membership
